


## BLS members on-line access to The Lichenologist

Every issue of *The Lichenologist* from Volume 1, Issue 1 is available on the Cambridge Journals Online system and are available free to those British Lichen Society members who opt to take *The Lichenologist*.

Below are details of how you can activate your on-line access to *The Lichenologist*. To do this you will need your 'Subscriber' number which is printed on the postage label of your copy of *The Lichenologist*

1. Visit the Cambridge Journals Online web-site at [journals.cambridge.org](http://journals.cambridge.org)

2. Select *Register* on the homepage and you will be taken through to the *Registration* page. If you have previously registered with the Cambridge Journals Online service then simply login and go to step 5.



3. Enter your details in the mandatory fields on the screen, including your email address, username and password. You can choose your own username and password and they can consist of letters, digits or a combination of both. You must accept the *Terms of Use* to register. After reading and accepting these, tick the relevant boxes towards the bottom of the screen and click the *Submit* button.

4. After a successful registration you will be taken through to the *Registration Successful* page (see below). Under *My Cambridge Journals Online* click on the field *Activate subscriptions* (NOT *Activate Society Subscriptions*).

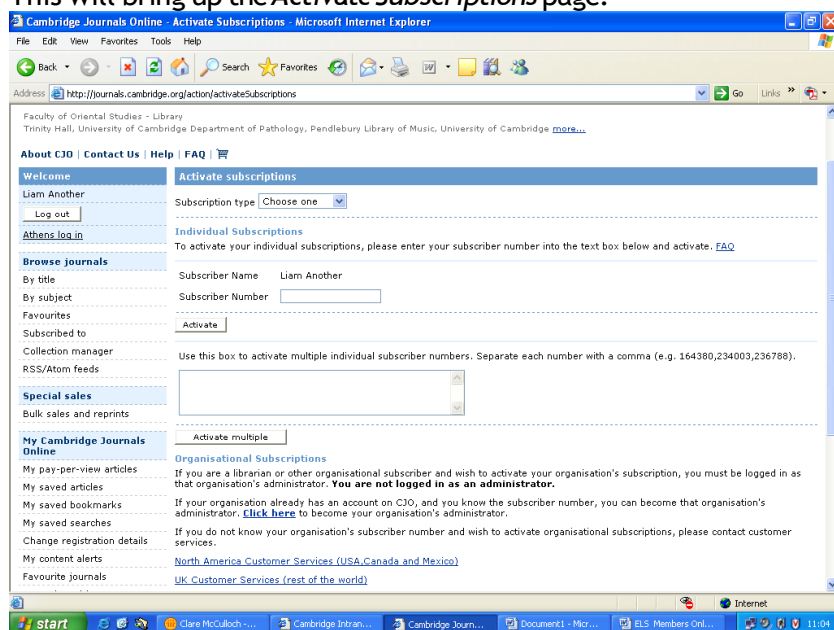

Click here 'Activate subscriptions' to activate your electronic access.

This will bring up the *Activate Subscriptions* page.



5. From the *Subscription type* drop-down menu choose *individual* and enter your six-digit subscriber number. Click on the 'activate' button. You should now be connected!

6. To access the journal and its papers, key 'Lichenologist' or part of the word into 'Cite search' and click the 'Find' button. This will present you with a description of the journal and give access by year, volume, part and paper. All papers are available to be downloaded in text-searchable .pdf format.

7. On subsequent occasions you will only need to login with your 'username' and 'password' before searching for 'Lichenologist'.

The registration and activation processes were designed to be as simple as possible, but you may have a query.
